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System Requirements

The application does not support Apple® Boot Camp® or any virtualization software

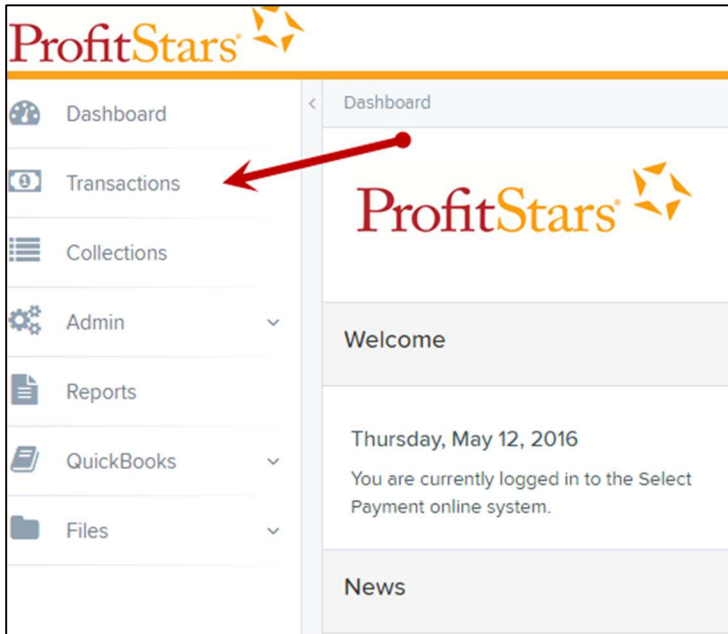

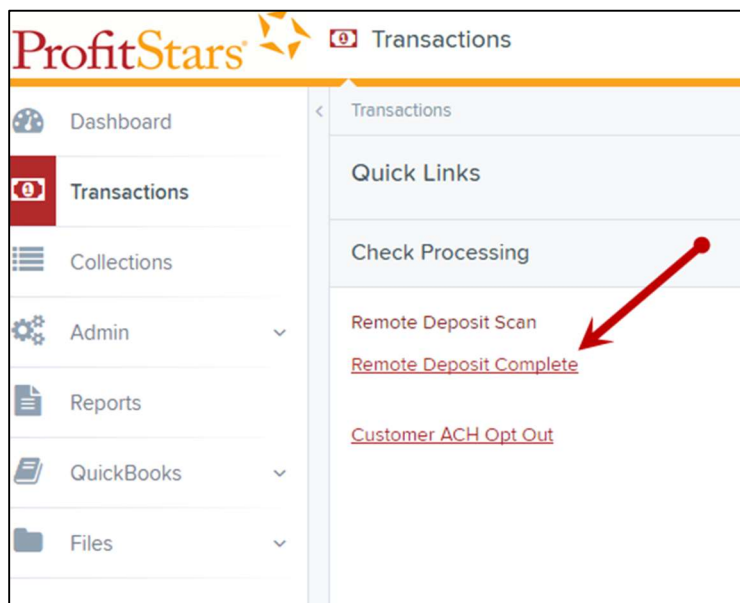
Installing Device Control

If you are accessing the application for the first time, you will need to install Device Control, a feature used to manage your scanner, before you can begin making deposits. During updates these steps will be the same. Your scanner can be connected at any point during the install.

1. Navigate to your financial institution's application and Login.
2. Select **Transactions** from the left main menu.



3. Under *Check Processing*, choose either **Remote Deposit Complete** or **Remote Deposit Scan**.

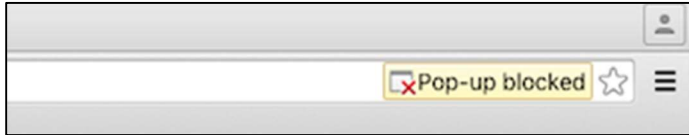


FIGURE 1 – POP-UP BLOCKED

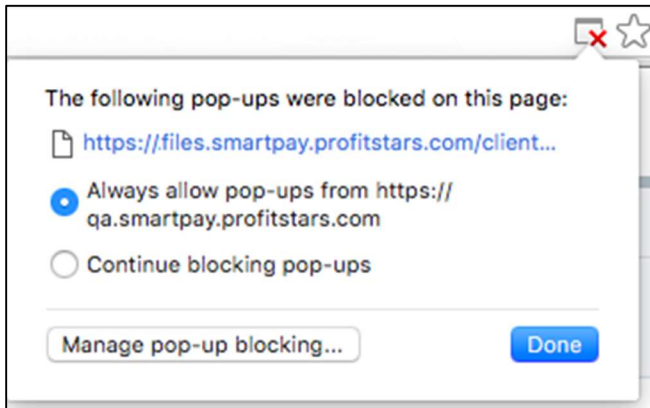


FIGURE 2 – ALWAYS ALLOW POP-UPS

6. Click **DeviceControllerInstaller....pkg** in the bottom left hand corner to begin the install.

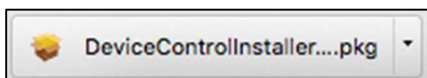


FIGURE 4 – DEVICE CONTROL

7. The *Install Wizard* tool appears. Select **Continue**.

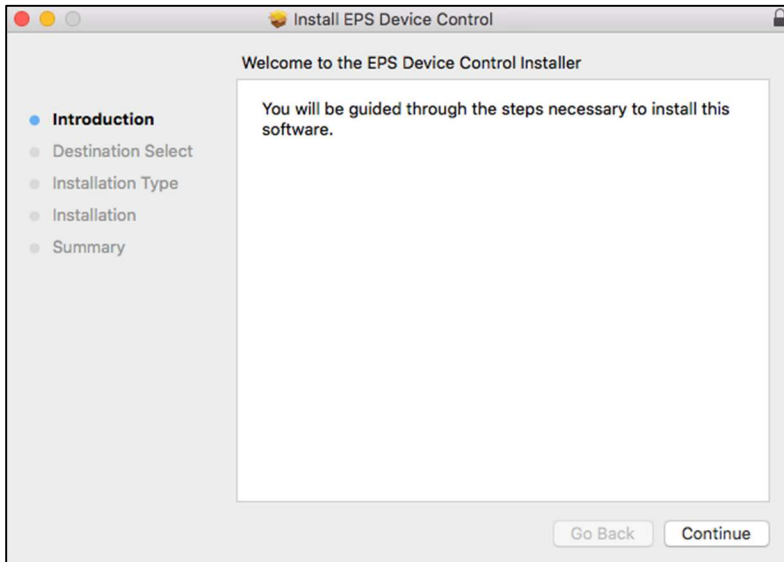


FIGURE 5 – INSTALL WIZARD

8. Click **Install**, as shown below.

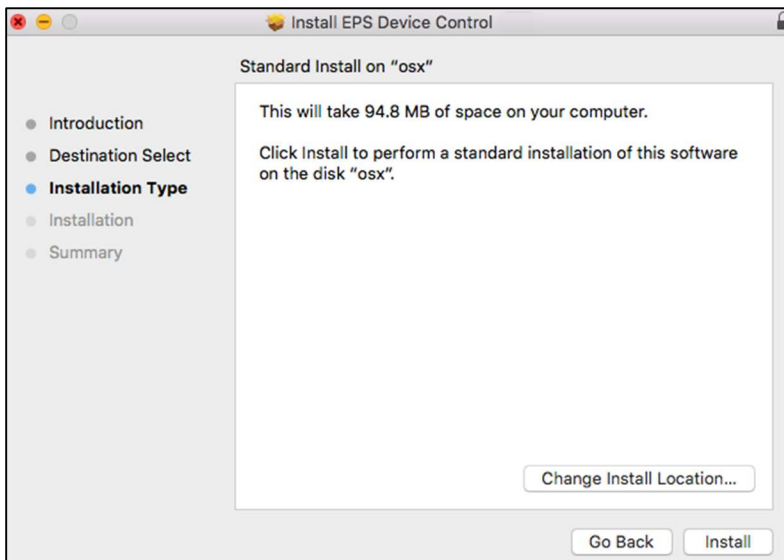


FIGURE 6 – INSTALLATION TYPE

9. If the message below appears, enter the admin username and password for your PC and then click Install Software.

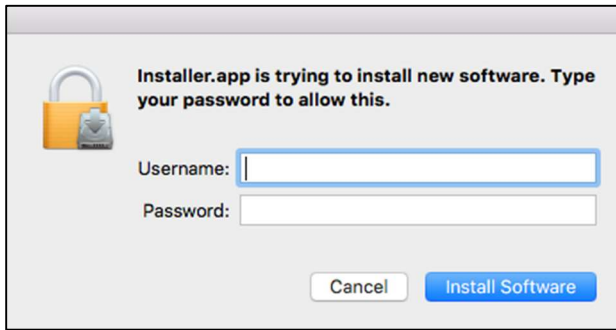


FIGURE 7 – ADMIN PROMPT

10. Click **Complete** on the *Complete Device Control Setup* window.

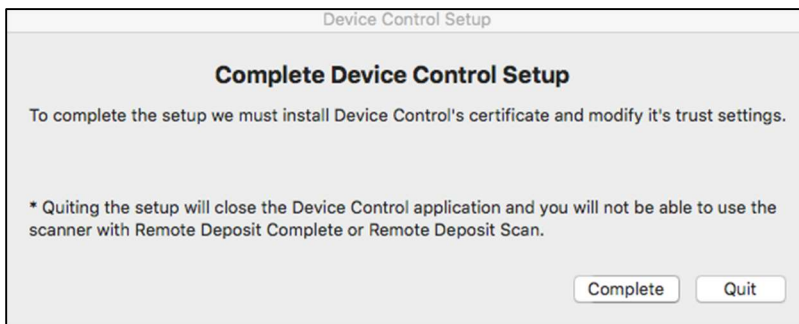


FIGURE 8 – DEVICE CONTROL SETUP

3. Choose **Go to Folder...**, as shown in the image below.

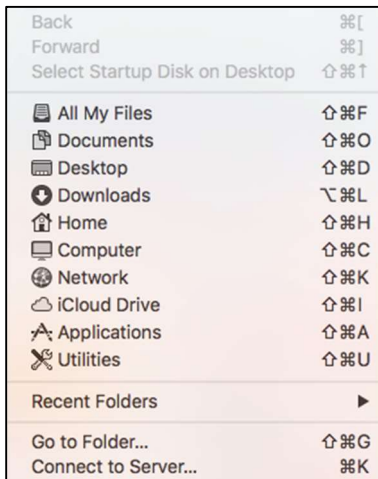


FIGURE 9 – GO MENU, WITH GO TO FOLDER OPTION

4. Type **~/Applications** and then click **Go**.

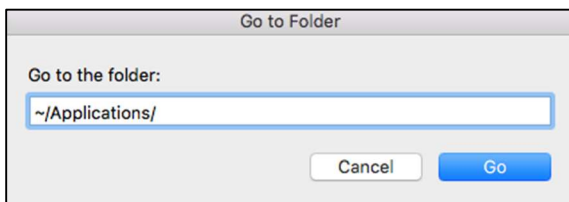


FIGURE 10 – GO TO FOLDER
